Farmhouse and Late 19th Century Vernacular Dwelling
(c. 1880-1910)

As the 19th century progressed, residential building styles took on more architectural character and detail. Old Hilliard contains several good examples of single-family middle class residences of the late 19th century. Although again "vernacular," these houses display more architectural variety than mid-19th century buildings in Old Hilliard. Porches with columns and other trim, decorative siding, or ornamentation at the gable are common features of these houses. In Old Hilliard, these dwellings are typically frame, but may also be constructed of brick. Built for farmers or other middle-class occupants, these residences are located on Main and Norwich Streets as well as several smaller side streets of Old Hilliard.
