

Dr. J. W. Renner Residence and Office

5281 Norwich Street (Map No. 9)

This intact brick early 20th century American Four Square house has been beautifully preserved and stands as an important Old Hilliard landmark. Built in 1916 by Dr. J. W. Renner for his home and office, the house was occupied after Renner's death by Dr. James W. Reason. Features of the building include front and side dormers, original slate roof, broad front porch, and an elaborate entrance with transom and sidelights.
